Due to its strategic geographical location, Graz Airport is firmly committed to bridge the economic stronghold areas of Slovenia, the Northern territories of Croatia, the South Western region of Hungary along with the states of Carinthia and Styria in Austria, underscoring its role as leading regional gateway for air cargo. Regular weekly RFS (Road Feeder Services) guarantee flawless trucking connections to the main European cargo hubs of major air carriers.



Logistics Hub

Graz Airport is perfectly located only minutes from the southern outskirts of the state's capital Graz - between the main highway A2, crossing the country from the North East all the way south to Carinthia and the border with Italy and the highway A9, connecting the region of Upper Austria in the North with the State of Styria in the South, bordering with Slovenia.

The close proximity to the Container/ Rail Terminal of Cargo Center Graz (CCG) in Werndorf next to the highway A9 only complements the notion of a dynamic logistics hub providing multimodal traffic solutions to the regional transportation as well as manufacturing industries.



Important business location

The state of Styria is a center of commerce with its industrial backbone represented by a large and diverse number of businesses (Import & Export) including the Manufacturing, Retailing, Pharma & Chemicals, Iron & Steel, Heavy Industry/Plant Construction, Automotive as well as the ICT sectors. Those economic areas perfectly complement one another with the largest industry segments of the neighboring countries within the catchment area of GRZ airport.
